

## Curiosity Shop Registration

Each year students in grades 1 through 5 look forward to signing up for a variety of one day enrichment classes through the PTA sponsored Curiosity Shop program. The classes are designed to stimulate curiosity and creativity. Classes are held right after school on one of the following Fridays: October 8th, 15th & 22nd. You may sign up each of your children for 2 classes.

If your child attends the YMCA After-School care, they too can attend as we will transport them from and back to their after-school care. Children who normally take the bus home simply stay after school on the day their class meets and we direct them to their class. Then, parents/guardians are responsible for arranging transportation home once class ends. Most classes end promptly at 4:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted. *We hope you like the offerings this year ~Heidi Todd (399-4004) and Traci Hall (557-2069).*

### How to Register for a Class

There are three ways to register:

- **Pre-registration: WE NEED VOLUNTEERS!** If you sign up to volunteer, you may complete the registration form and send payment into school **now** or anytime before **Friday, Sept. 17th**. We need help to monitor children during a class (2:30 – 4:00 p.m.) and at in-person registration night – simply indicate your availability on the registration form and you too can pre-register. If all the classes are not filled to capacity, we will also offer volunteers the chance to sign their children up for a 3<sup>rd</sup> class. It’s our way of thanking you – without volunteers, there wouldn’t be any classes at all! Be sure to sign the permission slip!
- **Registration Night: Tuesday, Sept. 21st-** 6:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. in the CHES Cafeteria. If you cannot make it, you can send the form and payment in with a friend who is attending that night. The permission slip included with these forms must be signed.
- **Back Pack Mail Registration:** If you cannot attend registration night and are not eligible for pre-registration, send your form and payment in to school **beginning Monday, Sept. 20<sup>th</sup>** and ending **Friday, Sept. 24th**. We will process those registrations after registration night and classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
